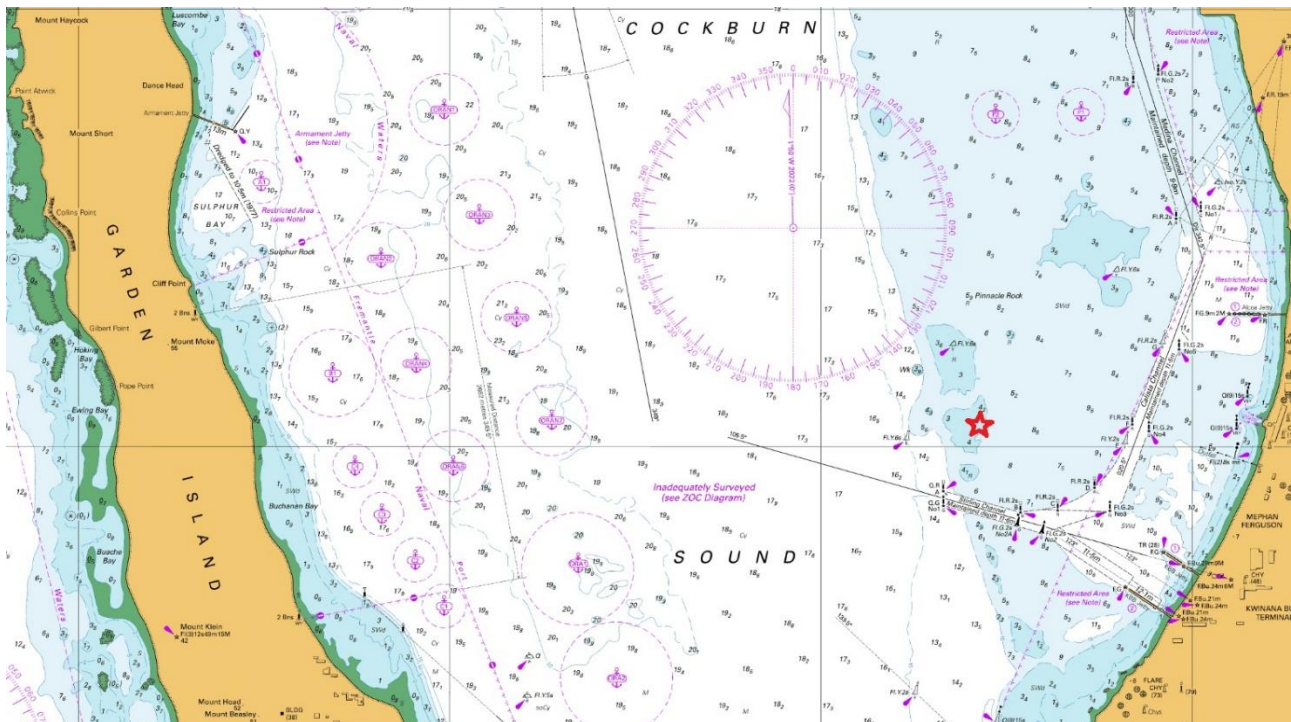

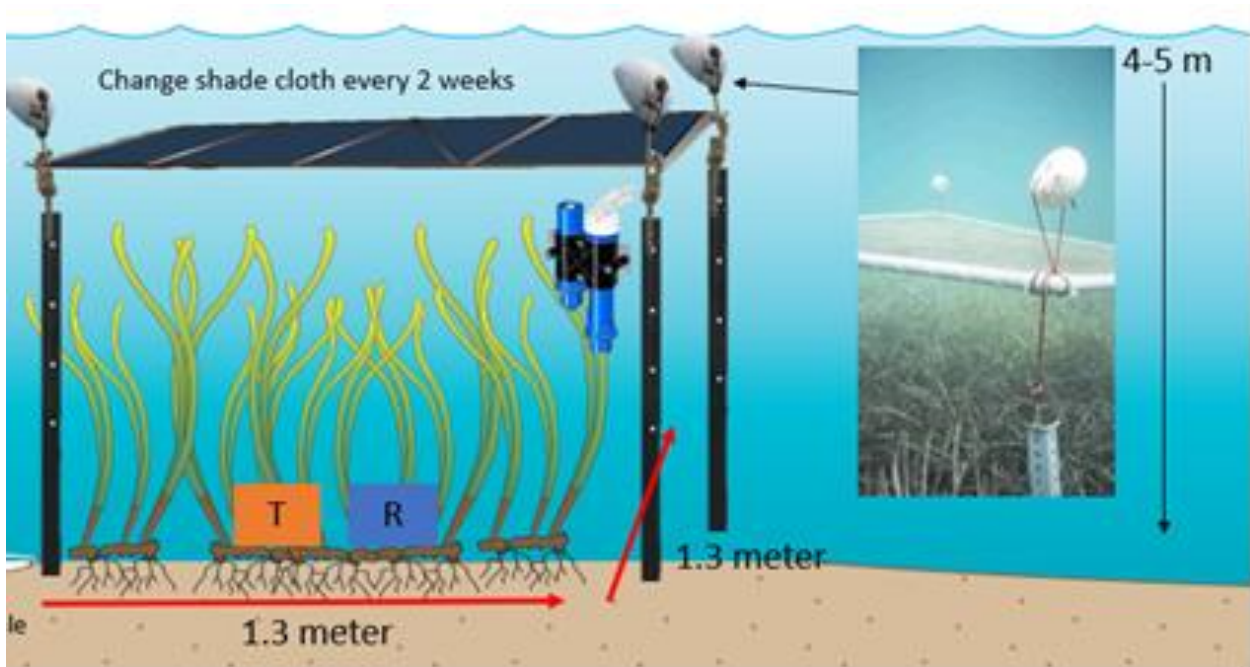

Cockburn Sound - Deployment of Scientific Equipment

Mariners are advised that twenty-four subsurface scientific instruments have been deployed in Cockburn Sound within 40 metres radius of 32° 11.86'S, 115° 44.84'E. The area is marked with 4 buoys with lights. The scientific equipment, 'plots', will have 4-star pickets with shade cloth. All plots are approximately 1 meter in height and will provide variable clearances to the surface of the water at LAT (Lowest Astronomical Tide) to be around 3-4 metres. The above instruments will be deployed as part of the WAMSI Westport Research Projects and will be recovered around April 2027. Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when transiting the area
