Prohibition of boat service to anchorage from KBT and KBJ

It has been noted that boat / launch service is being provided for surveyors to board at the Kwinana Bulk Terminal and the Kwinana Bulk Jetty berths. This service is provided by third parties to enable surveyors to transfer onboard vessels for cargo hold inspections at ORA anchorage.

All agents and service providers are to note that both, the Kwinana Bulk Terminal and the Kwinana Bulk Jetty facilities are Maritime Security Regulated Zones in accordance with the **Marine Transport** and Offshore Facilities Security Act and designated Mine sites in accordance with the **Mine Safety** and Inspection Act.

Entry to both facilities is permitted only if there is an operational need to be on site and not to undertake a boat service to the anchorage. Use of boat service is therefore strictly prohibited for the above transfers from these sites.

The above requirements are to be complied with immediate effect.
