REQUEST FOR PERMISSION form

Please note that this is the second of three presentations, which you should view in order.

(VERSION 5b)





Dangerous cargo that is identified as being high hazard, can not be moved through our port area without permission first being granted by the Dangerous Cargo Officer. Permission is sought by the agent filling in a **Request for Permission** form which is available in Voyager Dangerous Cargo on the Internet.

The purpose of this presentation is to show you how to fill in then submit this electronic form.

High hazard dangerous cargoes for which permission is required. . .

The transport and handling of dangerous goods must comply with Australian Standard AS3846-2005. A 24 hour specialist advice contact phone number must be made available for the dangerous cargo. AMSA Organisation must be immediately advised of your intention to import this substance. On completing of loading, the loaded ship or vehicle shall depart from the port area as soon as is reasonably practicable. The ship's engines and ancillary equipment shall be kept ready at all times, so that the ship can leave the berth at short notice.
