Deployment of scientific equipment - Cockburn Sound Vicinity

Mariners are advised that twenty-four subsurface scientific instruments are scheduled to be deployed on Friday 07th October 2022 in Cockburn Sound within 40 metres radius of 32° 11.86'S, 115° 44.84'E. The area is marked with 4 buoys with lights.

The scientific equipment, 'plots', will have 4-star pickets with shade cloth. All plots are approximately 1 meter in height and will provide variable clearances to the surface of the water at LAT (Lowest Astronomical Tide) to be around 3-4 metres.

The above instruments will be deployed as part of the WAMSI Westport Research Projects and will be recovered around May-December 2023.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when transiting the area.
