- Request for immobilisation must be sent to Fremantle Ports VTS minimum 24hrs prior to planned works
 - Report to VTS via radio CH12 for final approval before immobilisation commences and again when completed
 - Immobilisation of main engine will not be permitted in strong winds/gale warning
 - If hot work is required a separate hot work application is to be submitted
 - Approvals will only be provided for a maximum of 12 hrs for each request
 - Additional mooring ropes may be required to be deployed
 - It is a requirement for the vessel's outboard anchor to be lowered to the seabed if at berth
